Montserrat retreat center, founded in 1959, is located on a secluded inlet of Lewisville Lake in Lake Dallas Township. Two buildings provide lodging with sixty-seven private rooms with bath, each individually heated and air-conditioned. Its peaceful and tranquil campus embraces thirty-nine acres of lawn, trees and lakeshore to wander. A restful library and glass-walled dining room overlook an expansive lawn and lakeshore. The new Campion Hall provides two large conference rooms for retreats & meetings. The Chapel of St. Ignatius offers a place to worship and seats 100.

Bring comfortable casual clothes and walking shoes. Your room is completely furnished with bed linens, blankets, and towels.

The dining room is open all the time and you are welcome to drinks, hot and cold, and to fruit and snacks. Each day meals are served at 8 am, Noon and 6 pm.

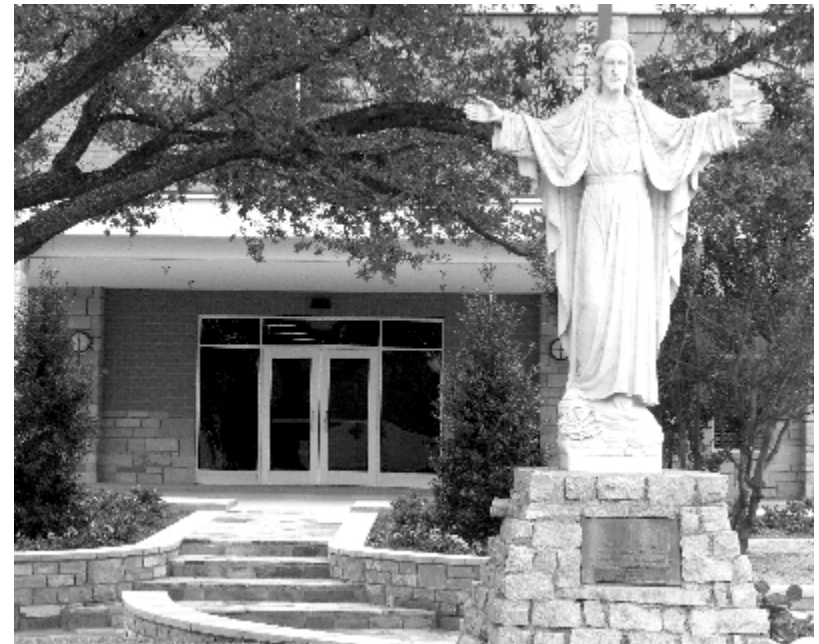
